It's Nice To Be Nice

The Wonder Stuff were one of the most popular UK's bands in the early 90's. Following their much-publicised split in the Summer of 1994, group members Malcolm Treece, Martin Gilks and Paul Clifford joined forces with former Eat frontman Ange Dolittle under the banner of We Know Where You Live.

The group released two singles and toured the UK extensively before splitting in 1996. During this time, they recorded almost two album's worth of material for potential release but the split came about before an album was released.

In April 2006, Martin Gilks died following a tragic road accident. His family asked for donations to be sent to CARE who run a residential home near Ironbridge and within a month, donations had topped £2000.


Since 1994, Robert Stokes has been running an unofficial fansite dedicated to the works of The Wonder Stuff and their spin-off projects including We Know Where You Live, Vent 414 (Miles Hunt's post-split project) and Miles' later solo work.

A few months after Martin's death, Robert contacted the surviving members of the group to see if it would be possible for him to release the demo tracks recorded by the group through his fansite, Room 512, with all profits from the album being donated to the CARE charity in Martin's memory.

On December 11th 2006, Room 512 will be exclusively releasing a double album of demo tracks and live recordings. The album will contain thirty tracks - 19 demos and 11 live recordings - recorded during 1995 and 1996. With the exception of a handful of tracks that came out on official or promotional singles, the rest of these tracks have never previously been released.

Pre-orders for the album are now being taken via the Room 512 website. The album will also be available at The Wonder Stuff's forthcoming Birmingham and London shows on 7th and 8th December respectively. For those looking for a last-minute Christmas present, Dolittle (Ange's latest project (highly recommended if you've not already seen/heard them)) will also have copies onsale at the launch of their own abum 'Hello To The Fortunate Few' in London on December 23rd.
